Next Week's BIG Match

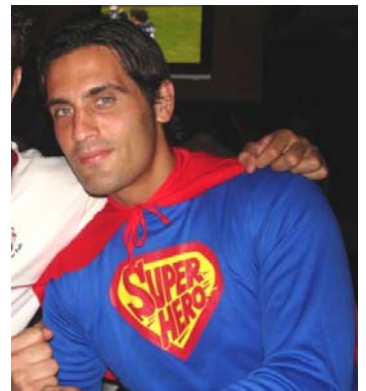
This Saturday the Dons are scheduled to play against Pattaya City with a 4.00pm KO in another match the Dons need to look for all the points in. Always a competitive game the
