Dons brush past British Club

Londoner threw off the shock of giving up a soft early goal as they eased to a 6-1 victory over the British Club to stay in the Championship hunt.

On a sweltering hot afternoon Dons got the game started kicking into the sun and were almost on the board with their first attack, Sureeya's first time strike being well saved low down by the British Club's stand in keeper. Indeed the opening minutes were being dominated by the Dons with fine passing play down both flanks only for them to be hit by a sucker punch as BC counter attacked quickly and Kemp dragged down the breaking player just outside the box to pick up a yellow card and give up a free kick. The kick flew straight into the bottom right hand corner of the net on Torrance's short side and he had to be annoyed with himself for not keeping it out. BC then almost doubled their lead when ex-Don James Worth found the ball at his feet 9 yards out with only the

keeper to beat but his initial shot rebounded back and the follow up ricocheted off the keeper's glove and over for a corner that came to nothing. Perhaps that was the wake up call required as within minutes Danai Downer broke through on goal only to be chopped down from behind for a penalty kick which he took after dusting himself down and fired home the equalizer. Sureeya then waltzed past a few defenders and ran in on goal and fired an unstoppable drive in off the cross bar to turn the game around in the space of a few minutes. As the pace noticeable dropped due to the intense heat Astengo did well on the left and his cross was met by a fine late run by Andrew Silvis who clinically fired home the Dons third goal of the game.

The second half started with BC trying to force themselves back into the game without really creating any chances and leaving themselves open to counter attacks and Alessandro Astengo took full ad-

vantage when put through as he finished with style to make it 4-1. Through out the second period the Dons were giving BC a torrid time down the right hand channel and a deep delivery to the back post was
